TO THE BMX DEPARTMENT

With the upcoming UCI BMX Supercross World Cup competitions, we want to bring a few existing rules to your attention. It is important that this information is transferred to the riders who participate at competitions on the UCI BMX calendar. The UCI commissaires will follow up these rules closely during all the BMX competitions.

CLOTHING

Art. 1.3.060 until art. 1.3.067 World Champion's jersey

Special attention to:

- World Champion:
World Champion jersey worn during **training** and racing at the event.
- World Champion Time Trial:
World Champion Time Trial jersey worn during **training** and time trial event only.

Art. 1.3.068 until art. 1.3.069 National champion's jersey

Special attention to:

- National Champion jersey worn during **training and competition**.
- National champions in BMX have the possibility to wear a distinct national champion jersey with the left arm sleeve representing the flag of the rider's country.

Art. 1.3.056 until 1.3.059 National Team clothing

Special attention to:

- The jersey should be submitted to the PCP for validation during the World Championships and the Olympic Games (following the IOC rules).
- For Championships classes, only approved National team clothing will be allowed. "Old" jerseys will not be allowed during the World Championships.

Art. 6.1.057 "Pants shall be loose fitting long pants made of tear –resistant material"

Pants made of denim are not tear resistant and are not permitted during BMX competitions.

Denim pants that are made with Kevlar material are authorized but they must have the label that has been approved by the UCI. All denim pants without this label are forbidden.

Riders not wearing the correct clothing will be sanctioned as per:

Art. 1.3.072 Infringements will be penalized immediately with a fine in part 1 of the rulebook.

SPECIAL ATTENTION TO:

Art. 6.1.056 Each rider who received a permanent career number must print this number on the back of the jersey.

GENERAL

Art. 1.2.131 Rider should always follow the instructions of the commissaires

If a rider doesn't follow the instructions, an official warning will be given.

If a rider still doesn't follow the instructions, the rider can be suspended for the competition and longer.

Art.6.1.021 Staging and gate positions

Riders have to be in the staging area at the appropriate times.

There will be a communication by the commissaires on the staging times. If a rider is not on time for staging, he/she loosed his/her gate pick position.

REGISTRATION

- Online Registration deadlines need to be respected.

- Riders confirmation will take place as indicated in the program.
- Late registration is only possible during the on site riders confirmation. Riders who register after 11.30 am during the riders confirmation will not be accepted to enter the race. Late registration can be done by the National Team Manager or by the individual rider with approval of the National Federation.

TRAINING

- All riders must train in their designated training group. No exceptions will be made. Stickers on the number plate will indicate the appropriate training group.
- All late registered men will practice automatically in training group B, regardless of their ranking or classification.

BIB'S

- All Nations will have the right to have one team bib. The bib's must be collected by the team manager during on site registration and should be returned immediately after practice. A deposit of 100 euro will be asked for the team bib's. Teams who don't return their bib, will lose the right to use the bib for the next Supercross event. Team managers can be asked to show their licence.

WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

REGISTRATION

- Art. 6.1.006 : Federations must do a licence check when they register for Masters category.
- Art. 9.2.048: A National Federation may enter up to three riders in total who do not meet the requirements of the criteria listed above.
- Online Registration deadlines need to be respected.
- Late registration after the online registration deadline is not accepted for Challenge classes.
- Riders confirmation will take place as indicated in the program. Late registration for Championships classes is only possible during Riders confirmation. Late registration can be done by the National Team Manager or by the individual rider with approval of the National Federation.

BIB'S

- All Nations will have the right to have one team bib during Championships practice. The bib's must be collected by the team manager during on site registration and should be returned immediately after practice. A deposit of 100 euro will be asked for the team bib's. Team managers can be asked to show their licence.
