

Willow Birdfeeder

Step 1



Find the natural curve of the willow and work with it by gently bringing the butt end of the willow to meet the tip making a teardrop shape. Leave a short butt end and long tip.

Step 2



Kink the tip end of the willow over the butt end and weave in a continuous circle all around the edge of the teardrop shape.

Step 3



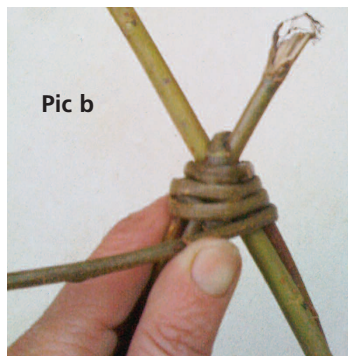
Continue weaving until you reach the tip end. Add in another willow rod by threading through the shape so that the butt ends form a 'v' shape.

Step 4



Weave around the shape until you come back up to the top of the butt ends.

Either continue weaving around the edge of the birdfeeder, tucking the tip in when finished (pic a) or wrap the remaining willow rod



tightly around the top several times and tuck in the tip through a gap in the weaving (pic b).

Step 5



Attach either a fat ball or pine cone coated in peanut butter and rolled in bird seed so that it hangs in the middle of the bird feeder.
